### STUDENT ACTIVITIES

- ◆ Student Activities provided 1597 opportunities for 976 MHS students in Athletics, Performing Arts, and Clubs/Organizations.
- ◆ 27 Clubs and organizations were offered to MHS students.

### PERFORMING ARTS

- ◆ Performing Arts provided 734 opportunities for MHS students.
- ◆ 184 Students participated in the Instrumental Music Program consisting of the Marching Band and two Concert Bands.
- ◆ 107 Student musicians participated in Solo and Ensemble at the District and State levels.
- ◆ 35 Student Musicians participated in the Pep Band before basketball games.
- ◆ 135 Students participated in the Vocal Music Program consisting of five choirs.
- ◆ Over 100 students participated in the two annual Talent Shows.
- ◆ 80 Students participated in five Musical Productions of **“Hot Mikado”** (52 cast, 16 technical crew, 12 orchestra).
- ◆ 58 Students participated in three Drama Performances of Christopher Durang's **“The Actors Nightmare and other Durange One Acts”** (23 cast, 35 technical crew).
- ◆ 30 Students competed in eight scheduled Forensics meets.

## ATHLETICS

- ◆ Athletics provided 857 opportunities for MHS students.
- ◆ 26 Varsity Sports (13 boys, 13 girls), and 24 Sub-Varsity Sports were offered.
- ◆ 571 Students participated in High School athletics representing 50% of the total High School population (1147 as of 3/1/06).
- ◆ 236 Female and 335 Male students participated in Athletics.
- ◆ 334 Athletes participated in one sport (138 Girls, 196 Boys).
- ◆ 188 Athletes participated in two sports (80 Girls, 108 Boys).
- ◆ 49 Athletes participated in three sports (18 Girls, 31 Boys).
- ◆ 182 Boys and 155 Girls participated in Fall Sports.
- ◆ 124 Boys and 81 Girls participated in Winter Sports.
