Last July, the Board of Education approved a 3-5 year <u>dynamic strategic plan</u> (DSP). The DSP serves as a roadmap for the future, guiding with five main targets. The genesis of this plan began eight months ago, gathering feedback from employees, students, parents, and community members. Through a thorough process, feedback was crafted into the framework you



see today. Since July, building department teams, staff, and administration have been working to create action items that support the goals outlined in the plan. You can expect quarterly updates at the Board of Education meetings. We're excited about this plan and its clear pathway for creating and enhancing our services to students and parents.

A few anticipated results from the DSP:

- creates a platform for aligned curriculum and services for our students;
- focuses on personalized, 21st Century focused academic rigor that provides multiple avenues of engagement for students;
- safe and secure facilities;
- ensures fiscal responsibility and health for long-term sustainability;
- establishes a master site plan a comprehensive infrastructure, facilities, and property plan for the future; and,
- focus on providing thoughtful, relevant training for our faculty and staff.
