

**MATTAWAN ATHLETIC BOOSTERS
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM**
Due Date: **Thursday, April 10, 2020**

Two scholarships, in the amount of \$1,500 each, will be awarded to one male and one female scholar/athlete each year. These scholarships will be awarded to members in good standing of the graduating class, who have earned at least one varsity letter and have continually displayed outstanding characteristics of a student-athlete during their high school career. The scholarships may be applied toward any level of further education attained within one year of graduation. Applicants do not need to participate in intercollegiate athletics to be eligible. However, applicants who have received/accepted a "full-ride" collegiate scholarship will not be eligible for consideration.

Submit **four (4) copies of all pages** of your application, **removing your name everywhere it appears - on reference forms and letters.** **Your application will not be accepted without all four copies.** When you have your four (4) completed packets done, group them together and put a note paper on top of the package with your name and reference number for office use in sorting applications.

Please do not include more than one reference from a teacher. Teachers should use the evaluation form provided in this document. Be sure to give the teacher a copy of the evaluation form to use, and remind them to copy it three more times when they are done. **But REMEMBER it is a Blind Evaluation. Your name should not be used** and the teacher may turn it into the Guidance office to Mrs. Galla. You may use character references from someone outside of your family. However, remember again, before you copy it to blacken out your name, and make sure you have the four copies.

All applicants will remain unknown to the selection committee based on numerical coding of each application – thus ensuring equal consideration of all applications. Therefore, carefully consider and respond to each of the following questions.
